**Affidavit of impeachment of [REDACTED]
the Student Government Association for Malfeasance**

Esteemed Members of the Student Senate of the Student Government Association at the University of Central Florida,

Whereas, Title VII Chapter 701 Section 701.1 of the Student Body Statutes specifies that any student at the University of Central Florida may file an affidavit for impeachment against any Student Government Association Agent;

Whereas, Title VII Chapter 701 Section 701.2 of the Student Body Statutes specify that any charges or complaints of wrongdoing may be filed by the student in affidavit form;

Whereas, Title VII Chapter 701 Section 701.2 of the Student Body Statutes specify that the Affidavit must include a description of what alleged wrongdoings were conducted and that the student may, but is not required to, list the provision of the Student Body Constitution, Student Body Statutes or Senate Rules that are alleged to have been violated;

Whereas, Title VII Chapter 700 includes Malfeasance as an offense punishable by impeachment;

Whereas, Title VII Chapter 700 defines Malfeasance to include the willful disregard of the Student Body Constitution;

Whereas, Article VI Section 3 of the student body constitution states that Graduate Students shall receive funds from Activity and Service Fees;

Whereas, Article VI Section 3 of the student body constitution stipulates that funds received by Graduate Students from Activity and Service Fees are Graduate Student Assembly fees;

Whereas, Article VI Section 3 of the student body constitution states that Graduate Student Assembly fees shall be allocated to the Graduate Student Assembly by the Activity and Service

Fee Committee at the start of the annual budget process and shall be administered by the elected group of representatives of the Graduate Student Assembly;

Whereas, Title VII, Chapter 803 Section 803.6 item J states that A&SF Budget Committee shall hold open hearings on all budgets, the schedule of which shall be provided to all budget-requesting student organization representatives and Student;

Whereas, the Graduate Student Association and the Student Council of the College of Medicine in collaboration with the administration of the Office of Student Involvement, the administration of Student Development and Enrollment Services, Student Senators, and the College of Graduate Studies submitted a budget request to the Activity and Service Fee Committee at the start of the annual budget process that would allocate Graduate Student Assembly fees to the Graduate Student Assembly;

Whereas, Title II Chapter 200 states that Roberts Rules of Order shall be the governing parliamentary authority of all Student Government Association meetings unless otherwise specified in the Statutes.

Whereas, the [REDACTED] of the Student Government Association, [REDACTED], is a Student Government Association Agent;

Whereas, Title VII Chapter 803 Section 803.2 states that the [REDACTED] is a member of the [REDACTED];

Whereas, Roberts Rules of Order charge a committee chair with the duty of determining if a motion is out of order, based on rules of the assembly, and not allowing the motion to be heard, or passed;

Whereas, The minutes of the Activity and Service Fee Committee state that the [REDACTED] of the Student Government Association, [REDACTED] introduced a motion not to hear the budget request to allocate Graduate Student Assembly fees to the Graduate Student Assembly;

Whereas, The minutes of the Activity and Service Fee Committee state that the motion made by the [REDACTED] Student Government Association, [REDACTED], not to hear the budget request for allocating Graduate Student Assembly Fees to the Graduate Student Assembly was upheld by the Activity and Service Fee Committee with a vote count of 10 in favor, 3 against, and 0 abstaining;

Whereas, the [REDACTED] of the Student Government Association, [REDACTED], allowed debate and vote on the question of submitting, hearing, and non-funding of the Graduate Student Assembly;

Whereas, the motion upheld by the Activity and Service Fee Committee not to hear the budget request to allocate Graduate Student Assembly fees to the Graduate Student Assembly is a willful disregard of the Student Body Constitution and Statutes; and

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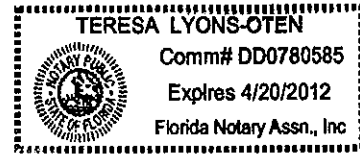
