- .04 Whereas, During the 2010 Football Season, UCF will play its first-ever Wednesday game at Bright House Networks Stadium;
 - Whereas, The UCF Knights will be playing UAB on Wednesday, October 6, 2010, at 8:00pm at Bright House Networks Stadium;
 - Whereas, The football game will be broadcast on ESPN and this prime time timeslot is an honor for the UCF Football team and

- Whereas, Parking issues currently exist during the regular school day, but on a game day, the presence of Knights fans would lead .14 .15 to additional congestion;
- Whereas, Tailgating on Memory Mall has become a tradition at the University of Central Florida and may interrupt classes taking .16 .17 place throughout the main campus:
- Whereas, The University of Central Florida will benefit by allowing classes to be cancelled during the October 6 football game by .18 .19 establishing that UCF supports the ever-growing Athletics Department and its outstanding athletics and fans who participate in
