NARRATIVE: The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the 15 of December 2011 at 3:13 AM at 4400 GREEK CT ORLANDO, FL (Zone: 22) in Orange County did

commit the offense of burglary to occupied dwelling and grand theft. He was identified via his Florida Driver's License.

Richard Nacewicz is an employee of Waste Management and on 12-15-2011 at approximately 0513 hrs was performing his duties in the area of Greek Park at the University of Central Florida. He observed a black colored pick-up truck park along the bushes of one of the fraternity houses (Sigma Chi). Mr. Nacewicz saw two men, Michael Minot and Brandon Geers, run from the truck to the center fraternity house (Kappa Alpha Theta). Mr. Nacewicz called the UCF Police Department and Officer Wenner (96) and I, Officer Strawn (111) responded.

Both officer Wenner and I arrived together within minutes of receiving the call and observed a dark gray colored Dodge pick-up truck parked along the bushes of the Sigma Chi House. The hood was very warm indicating that it had recently been driven. We walked around the building from the west side to the east. When we approached a northeast side door, it opened. Mr. Geers exited. He was holding a trophy (\$50) in his hands. He was wearing latex "surgical" style gloves on each hand. When he exited, we confronted him. Mr. Minot, who was about to exit behind Mr. Geers immediately withdrew inside the house, closing the door behind him. I called out to Mr. Minot to exit and after about 15 seconds, did so. Officer Wenner detained them while I investigated.

I contacted the House Manager, Laura Beinkampen, who was asleep inside the house at the time of the burglary. She advised that she did not know either Mr. Minot or Mr. Geers and that neither had permission to enter into the sorority house or take any of the property from the house. She and I walked the house to conduct an inventory. Located below the window adjacent to the northeast exit door was a pair of latex "surgical" style gloves. Approximately five feet from there was a table on which a Wii game system (\$300) was sitting. It's wires were rolled around the game as though it were bundled to be carried. Ms. Beinkampen advised that the Wii game belonged on a table across the room from where we found it. On a chair adjacent to the table with the Wii game was a decorative pot (\$35). On a landing in the western stairwell was a flower vase (\$20) but the flowers were missing. The vase did not belong in the stairwell but at this time, Ms. Beinkampen did not know where it belonged. Ms. Beinkampen provided a written statement advising that she and the Sorority House would prosecute.

I read both Mr. Minot and Mr. Geers their rights as per Miranda and the both stated that they understood their rights and they both agreed to be interviewed. They both said that they had met some sorority women earlier that evening and that they decide to do a prank on them by taking several items from the house. Neither of them knew the women and could not provide any of the woman's names.

Mr. Minot admitted to taking the Wii game system and decorative pot. When Officer Wenner told Mr. Minot that we were going to tow the vehicle and she asked for the keys, Mr. Minot told her that he had a concealed weapons permit and that he had a handgun in the truck's glove box. Officer Winiers retrieved a Glock 27 (.40 cal. s/nPTL518). It had five rounds of ammunition in the magazine but none chambered. Mr. Minot was charged with Burglary to Occupied Dwelling, Grand Theft and Possession of Firearm on School Property.

Mr. Geers admitted to taking the trophy. He advised that he knew Mr. Minot had a firearm in the truck. Mr. Geers was charged with Burglary to Occupied Dwelling and Grand Theft. Although the property that he took was only valued at \$50, he co-conspired to commit a grand theft. Although Mr. Geers knew that Mr. Minot possessed a firearm while on the school's property, he was not charged with it's possession since it was encased (in the glovebox) of Mr. Minot's vehicle.

Mr. Minot is the registered owner of the truck used to transport them to the scene of the burglary. The truck was towed to Tibbitt's Towing to be seized for forfeiture.
