On February 28, 2008 Fraternity and Sorority Life received an email sent to our Anti-Hazing email account. The email read Mu Sigma Upsilon is hazing the new pledges and are verbally abusing them and putting their hands on them. I do not think this is right. The sender was [redacted], who is the sister of one of the new pledges for Mu Sigma Upsilon. The office also received a phone call from [redacted] on our Non-hazing Hotline asking that someone from the office call her immediately regarding the same matter. As the Director of Fraternity and Sorority Life, when I became aware of this situation, I immediately contacted [redacted] to get the full scope of the situation. Upon calling [redacted], she proceeded to inform me that her sister was being hazed by Mu Sigma Upsilon (Mu) Sorority. She stated that the girls are not allowed to eat certain food or eat at all without permission, they are sleep deprived and they are verbally abused daily. She also stated that the members of the organization demean the women by stating that they are not worthy to look them in the eyes. While [redacted] was on the phone her sister walked into the room. [redacted] proceeded to have a conversation with her sister regarding this matter and I

immediately heard shouting and a very emotional woman on the other end. The sister and if they find out that [redacted] stated that she really wanted to be a member of this organization, [redacted] stated, "It's not ok for them to be mean to you, or deprive you of food and sleep, or treat you this way!" The sister responded, they can treat me anyway they want as long as I can become a member. While this conversation was taking place [redacted] was very upset, she was crying and screaming at her sister not to go forward with the complaint. The phone suddenly became silent. [redacted] came back to the phone and continued her conversation with me. At this time I thanked her for not hanging up while she and her sister discussed this matter. I also urged her to indeed move forward and submit a report to the Office of Student Conduct. I then forwarded the incident form link to [redacted]. On February 29, 2008, [redacted] emailed again and asked if she could submit the report anonymously. I informed her that she could, but it would simply be for informational purposes only. I also informed [redacted] that I would file a report based on the conversation I heard. [redacted] email address is [redacted] and her phone number is [redacted] is the new pledge who wants into the organization. [redacted] her sister email address is [redacted]. Her cell phone numbers is [redacted]. The phone call I listened in on was very disturbing. The [redacted] was very upset and seemed desperate to belong to this organization that she would allow them to do anything to her to belong. Lots of red flags and the appearance of clear hazing situations!
