This report is for informational purposes only. Alleged incident occurred in Orange County, in University of Central Florida Police Department jurisdiction.

On 02/11/2011 at approximately 0500 hours, I was patrolling the area of McCulloch Rd. and Old Lockwood Rd., Seminole County, when I was flagged down by a male driving a work truck. The driver advised me there was a subject lying on the side of McCulloch Rd., approximately a half-mile east of the intersection of Old Lockwood Rd. I checked the area, and observed a prone figure wearing blue jeans and a red hoodie lying in the grass on the north side of McCulloch Rd. I parked my vehicle in the roadway and activated my emergency lights for safety and visibility.

As I approached the subject, I observed the him to be a white male in his early twenties. I saw that he was breathing, and attempted to wake him by calling out and shaking his shoulder. He did not respond to my repeated attempts to wake him, and I could smell the distinct odor of alcohol emanating from him. I requested Fire Rescue to respond, and resorted to a sternum rub to attempt to wake the subject, which met with success. The subject, later identified through DAVID as M..., was disoriented and unable to sit up. I asked him his name, and he stared at me. His eyes were unfocused and glassy. I asked him his name again, and he told me "...". I asked him if he knew where he was, and he said "home."

At this point, ... sat up with assistance, and I asked him where "home" was. ... said "Avalon Park." I asked him where in Avalon Park, and he was "by the Wal-Mart." It should be noted that the location in Avalon Park ... described is at least 6-7 road miles from the location I found him. There was also an overnight low temperature in the high 30's, and a current temperature of 47 degrees when I located him. ... was very pale and shaking with cold.

I asked ... if he remembered how he got to his current location, and he said, "my fraternity fucled me over." I asked him what fraternity he was in, and he said, "DTD." I am familiar with fraternities, having been previously employed with the University of Central Florida Police Department, and recognized "DTD" to stand for Delta Tau Delta. I confirmed this with ..., and he agreed DTD stood for Delta Tau Delta. ... then told me he was "pledging them this semester." I asked him what had happened the previous evening, and he said, "I had to do something to get into the fraternity." I asked ... what that was, and he told me, "I had to drink more than the brothers, so they had me pound




drinks." [redacted] then told me, "I didn't drive here, someone else did." [redacted] told me he thought whoever drove him here dropped him off at his house in Avalon Park. I asked [redacted] if he attended UCF, and he said yes. I asked him if the drinking occurred at Delta Tau Delta's fraternity house in Pegasus Landing Apartments (Orange County), and he said "yes."

[redacted] was checked and cleared on-scene by Orange County Fire Rescue 6. [redacted] requested he be transported to Pegasus Landing to retrieve his house keys, and a taxi be called for him there to transport him to his residence in Avalon Park.

I advised the on-duty supervisor at the UCF Police Department, Cpl. Chuck Reising, of the incident, and he requested I complete an Information report and Student Affairs Referral on the Delta Tau Delta Fraternity.
