Student Initiatives and Representation

- Eagerly represent student issues and work with administration to resolve them.
- Partner with State Representative Mariano to pass legislation to provide Bright Futures funding during the summer semester.

Transparency and Accountability

- Publish Board of Trustees easy to read summaries on SGA website and social media.
- Enforce Platform Tracker to update the Student Body on the positive progress that is being made
- Hold monthly cabinet member evaluations to ensure accountability within the Executive Branch.
- Build unity with the Legislative Branch by calling upon them to help resolve issues that the Student Body is facing.
- Work with the Legislative Branch to continuously improve spending policy so funding is used more efficiently.
- Work closely and directly with local media to ensure truthful and informative articles.

Transportation and Safety

- Create an immediate parking alleviation by working with parking services to create and redefine parking decals.
- Reduce partnership with KnightLynx shuttle service and reallocate funds to UBER discount that will be offered to all UCF students.

- Develop SGA budgetary plan to improve security by supporting camera installation in parking garages.
- Green Dot Bystander Intervention Training for all Registered Student Organizations.
- Finalize the installation of lighting in the off-campus Greek housing area.
- Work with UCFPD and OCSO to dedicate more police resources to preventing violent crime instead of victimless crime.
- Emphasize the importance for UCFPD and OCSO to make frequent rounds in high crime off campus housing areas.
- Implement and educate students on a risk management plan in the event of natural disasters.

Health and Happiness

- Increase awareness of Mental Health Services on campus by creating initiatives with avenues that reach all students, such as Webcourses.
- Advocate for an increase in free STD testing.
- Actively fight to defend students' rights to wear reasonable attire such as stringers to the RWC.
- Guarantee the addition of a squat rack in the RWC.
- Encourage greater dietary diversity amongst UCF dining.
- Improve and increase trash and recycling bin locations on campus.
- Partner with Veteran Academic Resource Center to provide more discounts for UCF Veterans.
- Advocate for free women health products.

University Pride and Student Experience

- UCF Shirt Tradeoff: Bring in another University's shirt and trade it for a UCF shirt.
- Use SGA funds and resources to enhance tailgate and game time experience Ex: "UCF Football Concert Series"
- Provide UCF away game bus transportation for one Football game and one Spring Athletics game.
- Advocate for beer to be available in the student section of the Football Stadium.
- Hold Pep Rallies at Memory Mall the day before a football game with UCF Athletics.
- Advocate for programs to unite UCF campuses. Ex: "Night at the Rosen".
- Encourage veterans to apply the skills gained in the military as leaders on campus as members of student organizations.
- Boost school spirit by encouraging professors to cancel classes and campus activities during Spirit Splash.
